

LAUREL SPRINGS POOL USE INFORMATION

Pool Hours: 11:30 AM to 7:30 PM

AGE REQUIREMENT

Children under the age of 12 are not permitted in the pool area unless accompanied by an adult. Unsupervised children distract the lifeguards from doing their job properly and therefore compromise the safety of everyone at the pool.

POOL MEMBERSHIP

A new membership must be purchased through the office each season. Separate badges, each of a different color, are used for adults (ages 18+), juniors (ages 12-17), and children (ages 6-11). The fee for a base membership for the household includes either one adult or one junior badge. Additional members must live in the household and may be added for an additional fee. There is no discounted fee for replacement of lost badges – the cost is the same as the membership fees. All members must sign in with their badge number upon entering the pool area, and absolutely no one may enter without a badge. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Please contact the office at 610-779-9596 for the fee schedule for the current season.

GUESTS

All guests must be accompanied by a resident. A guest fee of \$5 per day is payable to the lifeguard and a disposable wristband will be issued for the day. A pack of guest wristbands may be purchased from the office upon advance request for the discounted price of \$40 for 10.

RESTROOMS

The restrooms in the clubhouse are off-limits for the pool. A portable restroom for those using the pool is located outside the pool area. No one is permitted in the clubhouse unless doing business with the office.

DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

Per the Declaration, the Association has the right to "suspend enjoyment rights of any member for any period during which any assessment remains unpaid." Residents of units with delinquent accounts must surrender their tags immediately and will not be permitted to use the pool until their account is paid in full. The lifeguard will be provided with a list of the names, addresses, and tag numbers of those not permitted to use the pool; however, all account questions and payments must be directed to the office.

POOL RULES

Please acquaint your children and guests with the attached rules. Anyone entering the pool area is assumed to know, agree to, and abide by these rules. These rules must be observed in order to assure the safety of all who use the pool. The lifeguard has the ultimate authority and will expel anyone for the day that is not adhering to the rules or not obeying the lifeguard. This lifeguard also has the authority to close the pool for any safety issue, to enforce the rules, or to call local police if necessary. Anyone found to be continually violating the rules will be expelled for the season by the Board of Directors. Any questions regarding either the decision to expel or the enforcement of rules shall be directed to Board at the next scheduled Board meeting, and not the lifeguard on duty or the Manager.

POOL RULES

- 1) Bathing suits are proper attire in the pool – street clothes are not to be used as a bathing suit.
- 2) No one, at any time, is permitted in the pool area without a lifeguard present.
- 3) Anyone in the pool area must obey the lifeguard on duty.
- 4) Any activity, in or out of the pool, which may subject anyone, including oneself, to potential harm is strictly prohibited. This is at the discretion of the lifeguard on duty.
- 5) No running in the pool area.
- 6) No running dives into the pool.
- 7) Only forward-standing dives with arms extended above the head can be made, and only into the deep water side of the buoy rope. No other dives are permitted.
- 8) No pushing, pulling, or throwing anyone into the pool.
- 9) No children under 12 years old are permitted in the pool area without adult supervision.
- 10) No alcoholic beverages are permitted in the pool area.
- 11) Food is only permitted on the grass.
- 12) No items made of glass or porcelain are permitted inside the fence surrounding the pool area.
- 13) No water guns of any kind, Frisbees, balls, rafts, surfboards, or tire tubes are permitted in the pool area. Fun noodles are permitted providing there are not a lot of people in the pool. This is at the discretion of the lifeguard on duty.
- 14) No animals are permitted in the pool area.
- 15) Trash and recycling receptacles must be used.
- 16) Clubhouse restrooms are off-limits. A portable restroom for the pool is located outside the pool fence.
- 17) Smoking is not permitted in the pool area.
- 18) No one is permitted in the pump house at any time except authorized staff.
- 19) Profanity and/or abusive language or behavior is not permitted in the pool area.
